Special Gifts Acceptance Policy

What We Do

Edmonds Unitarian Universalist Church **encourages** its members, friends, and constituents to support the church through special gifts or donations made in addition to their yearly Operating Fund pledge. Special gifts refer to gifts distinct from donations designated for either general operating funds, capital funds, approved earmarked funds or the endowment funds of the church. Non-designated memorial gifts and honoraria shall be considered special gifts.

Why We Do It

We encourage special gifts to further the mission and vision of the congregation. The board of Trustees through Congregational election has accepted the obligation to be the fiscal guardians of the congregation and thus the obligation to evaluate and make decisions in the best interest of EUUC.

How We Do It

The Board of Trustees shall accept or reject any special gift. Once a special gift has been received and accepted by the Board, it is irrevocable.
