Responding to the twin challenges of peak oil and climate change usually entails cutting back, reducing, consuming less, doing without. Although these individual efforts are essential, they don't address the systemic changes necessary if we are to successfully transition from the Age of Cheap Oil. Transition Towns offer a positive, solutions-focused approach that engages whole communities in a transformative process that accepts the crucial need to reverse course and develop new, ecologically sustainable urban and rural systems. Over this six week class, we'll read through *The Transition Town Handbook* that lays out a vision of a materially leaner but inwardly richer human experience. Transition Towns take off where our Common Security Club group left off. Our text is "The Transition Handbook—from oil dependency to local resilience" by Rob Hopkins.
